



Lifeguard Rules for Private Parties

1. Your lifeguard is required to enforce all Beach Rules while on duty; you should provide your lifeguard with a copy of the Beach Rules prior to your party to allow them to familiarize themselves with these rules.
2. Your lifeguard is not dedicated exclusively to your guests; they are responsible for all members and guests using the beach and lake.
3. Your lifeguard (in conjunction with any lifeguard(s) on duty as part of the Association's normal operations) has the complete authority and control over the safety and well-being of all members and guests. Their determinations in this regard are final and must be complied with, including by you and your guests. Lifeguards have complete authority to suspend the beach privileges of anyone who does not comply with their directives or the Beach Rules, including you and your guests.
4. When your lifeguard is on duty at a time when another lifeguard is on duty as part of the Association's normal operations, one lifeguard should be positioned at the swim platform and the other at the lifeguard stand on the beach. The lifeguards have complete authority over their deployment in this regard.
5. Your lifeguard may request the assistance of any adult member, but you should be available and ready to support them. You are ultimately responsible for their performance or failure to perform.
6. Your lifeguard must be able to hear a call for assistance while on duty and is not permitted to use any device that may interfere with that. You are responsible for controlling music and other sound levels of your party and guests accordingly.
7. Your lifeguard must be able to see all swimmers and be alert while on duty and is not permitted to read, sleep or conduct any other activities that may interfere with that. You are responsible for ensuring that your party and guests do not obstruct the lifeguard's view of the water and that your guests do not engage the lifeguard in conversations that may distract them from their responsibilities.
8. Your lifeguard must be in proper swim attire (and otherwise prepared to perform their duties) at all times while on duty.
9. Your lifeguard is required to be on duty at all times during your party. Any use of the lake by you and your guests when your lifeguard is not on duty is solely at your (and their) own risk and you will indemnify and hold harmless the Association and its officers, trustees and members from and against any and all costs, losses, claims (including, without limitation, those of your guests), damages, liabilities or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees), as incurred, arising in any manner out of your or your guests' use of the lake when your lifeguard is not on duty.

Without limitation on any other rights the Association may have, failure to comply with these rules may lead to suspension or revocation of Association membership privileges and all other penalties provided by the Association's Bylaws, at the Board's discretion.
